COURSE DYNAMICS

Advanced and critical training, structured in 13 weekly modules with a blended theoretical-practical approach: Presentation of conceptual content and inspiring case studies; Synchronous class (approx. 3 hours) to delve deeper into the topic with the same instructor; Synthesis sessions ("islands") for collective reflection and sharing of learning; Independent activities with graded assignments (4 projects) to ensure the application of critical thinking in real-world contexts. The experience is designed to foster an individual perspective on alternative economic models and their social and environmental impact, with an emphasis on contextualized practice.
